Members of the public may address the Board at any regular meeting. Persons wishing to address the School Board are requested to contact the Clerk of the Board for placement on the agenda in accordance with School Board Regulation BDDH-R.

The Board Chair is responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and shall rule on such matters as the appropriateness of the subject being presented and length of time for such presentation. No one will be allowed to make additional presentations until everyone who wishes to speak has an opportunity to make an initial presentation.

A reasonable period of time, as determined by the School Board in accordance with Regulation BDDH-R, will be allocated at each regular meeting for community members to present matters of public concern related to the operation of the school division.
